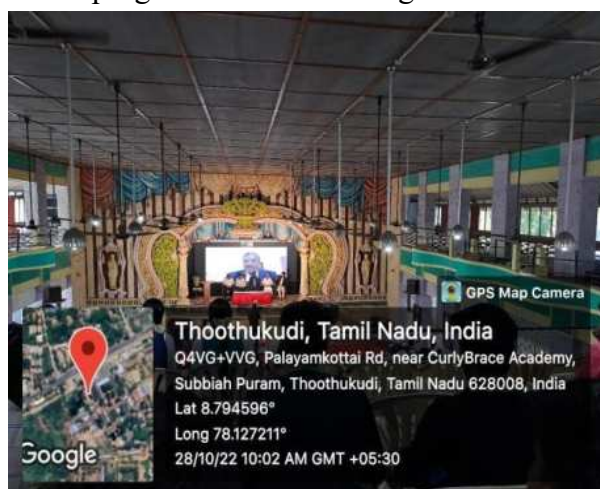
Mary's College addressed the gathering.

enlightened the students minds with thoughtful insight.



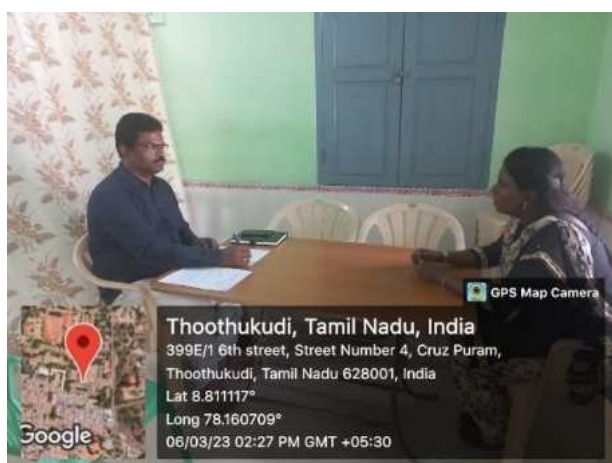

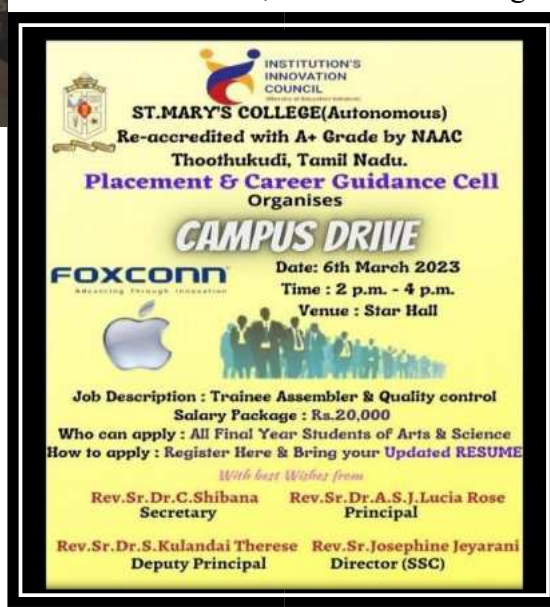
