PTA AND ALUMNAE

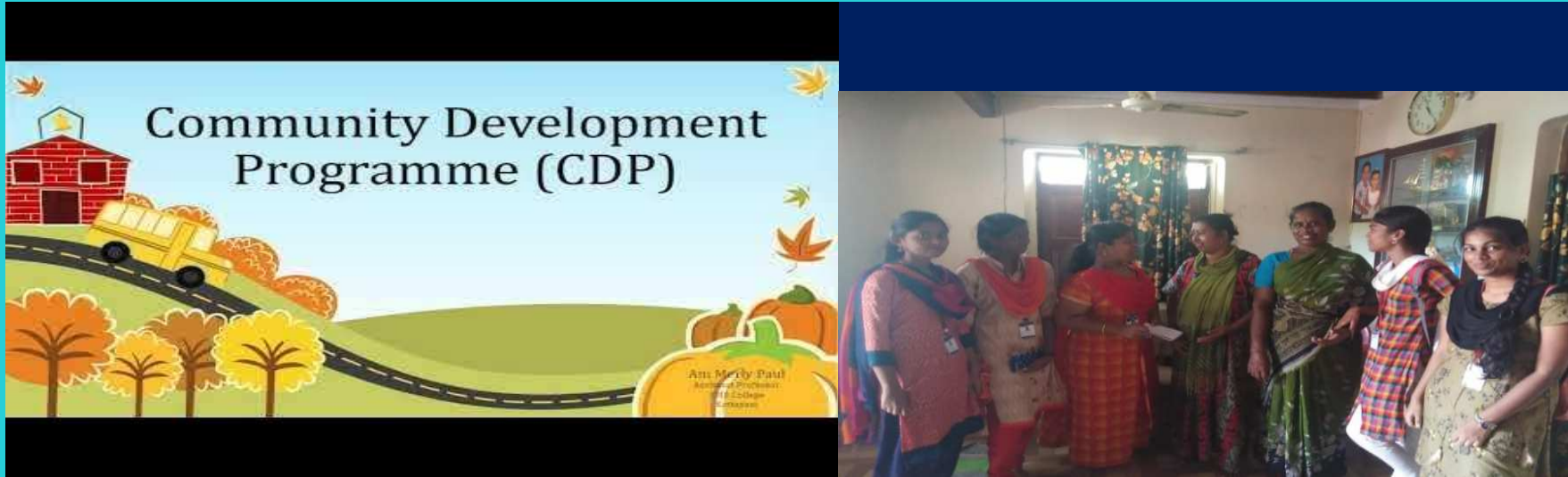
