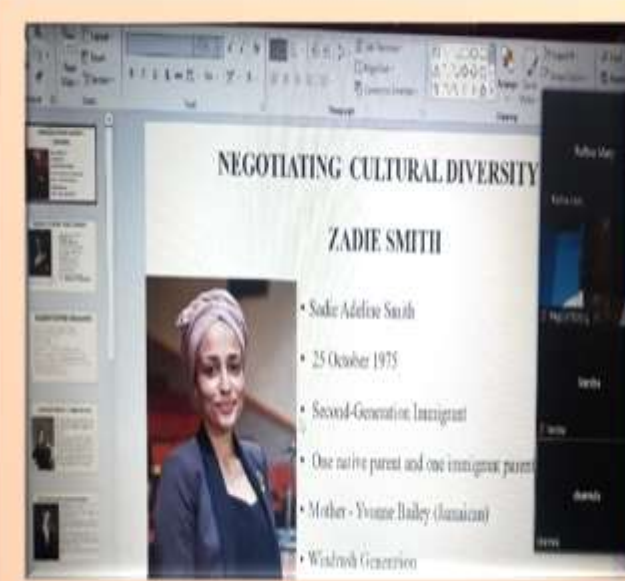

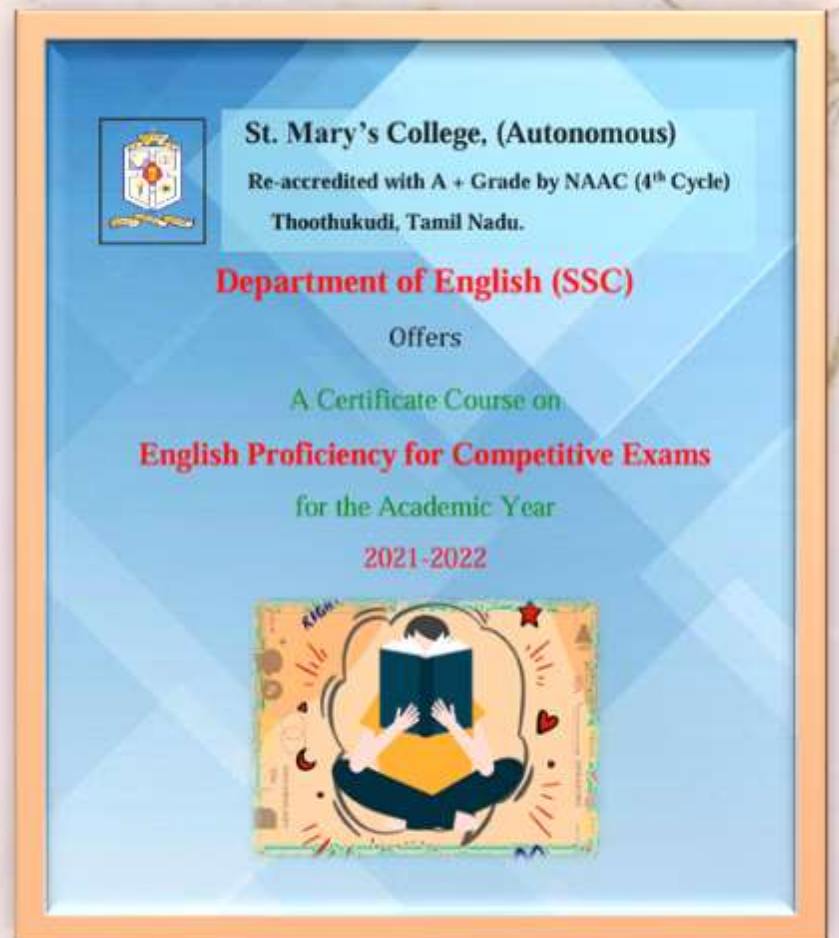


Bridge Course

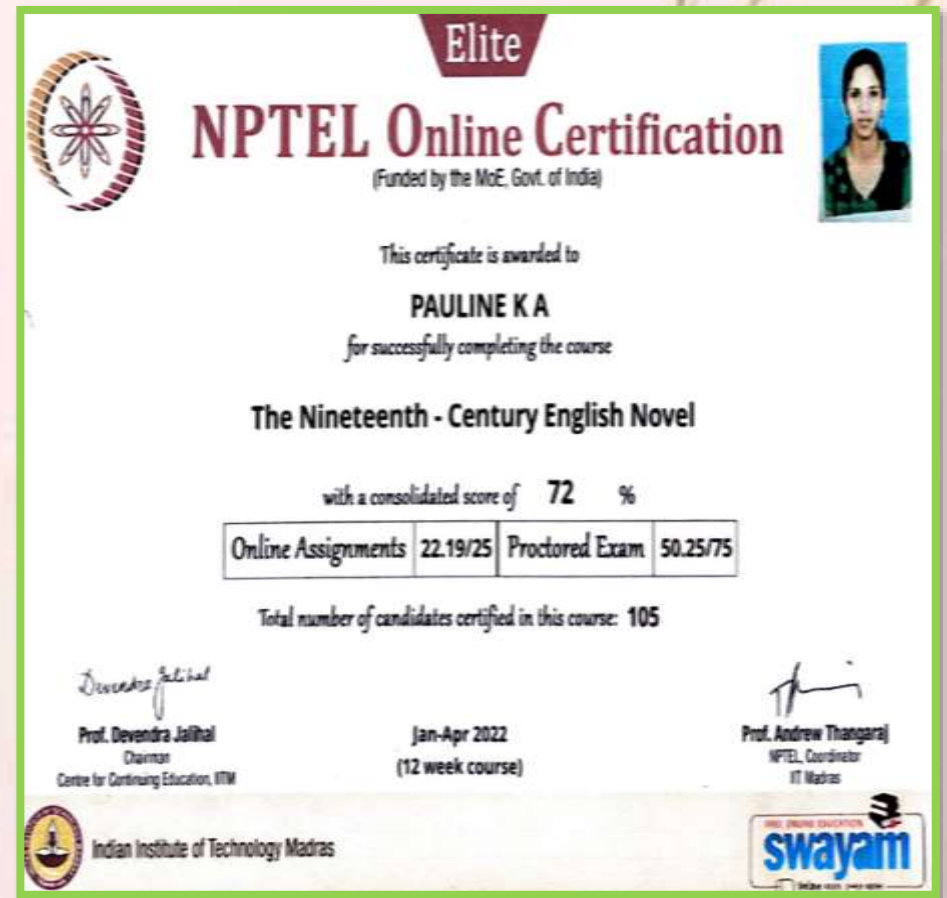
