# Minutes of the Planning and Evaluation Committee Meeting 26.07.2018

The meeting of the Planning and Evaluation Committee was held on the 26<sup>th</sup> of July at 3 p.m. in the Audio-Visual Room under the chairmanship of Dr. Sr. A.S.J. Lucia Rose, the Principal. The meeting commenced with an invocation to God Almighty. Rev. Sr. Principal welcomed the members and introduced the external expert to the committee.

Dr. Mary Judith Reene Fernando, Dean, School of Management & Economics read the minutes of the previous meeting of planning and evaluation.

A report of the action taken, based on the various events and happenings of the previous academic year, was presented by Dr. S. Thenmozhi, Dean, School of Language & Culture.

Dr. P.J. Joslin, Dean, School of Biological Sciences presented a brief report of the action plan for the current academic year 2018-2019.

Rev. Sr. Principal spoke of the new programme M.A. English Literature to be commenced from the next academic year in SSC. Sr. Principal also said that the proposal for starting the new programme has been approved by the Society Governing Body and is proposed to commence from the next academic year 2019-2020.

Rev. Sr. Flora Mary, the secretary presented the Action Plan regarding infrastructure development. She opined that a dispensary is an immediate requirement to give medical care to students who fall sick unexpectedly. He also applauded the efforts taken by the college to conduct the meeting in an organized manner. He also offered the following suggestions:

- Faculty members must update and acquire knowledge by attending Faculty Improvement Programmes.
- Implement strict examination system and flexible evaluation system to enhance the growth of the student community.
- Provision of life skills along with curriculum be made mandatory.
- Conduct of inter-disciplinary Seminars with a focus on its benefits.
- Identify the uniqueness of students right from the year of entry to channelize them in a fruitful manner.

Research scholar, Ms. Esther Elsie suggested the provision of lab facilities to scholars from other colleges at a nominal fee.

Students expressed their desire to undergo Internship. They also were happy about Mentor-mentee system which enables them to get personal counselling and career guidance. They were thoroughly satisfied with self-study courses which paved way for mastery of new subjects.

Sr. Shibana opined that a job fair should be conducted for getting good placements for students in the campus. In this regard, Dr. Sugumar expressed his opinion that a good link with alumnae could promote placement opportunities.

After a healthy discussion and interaction, Dr. T. Linda Fernando, Dean, School of Physical & Computing Sciences proposed the Vote of thanks. The meeting then concluded with the College Anthem.
