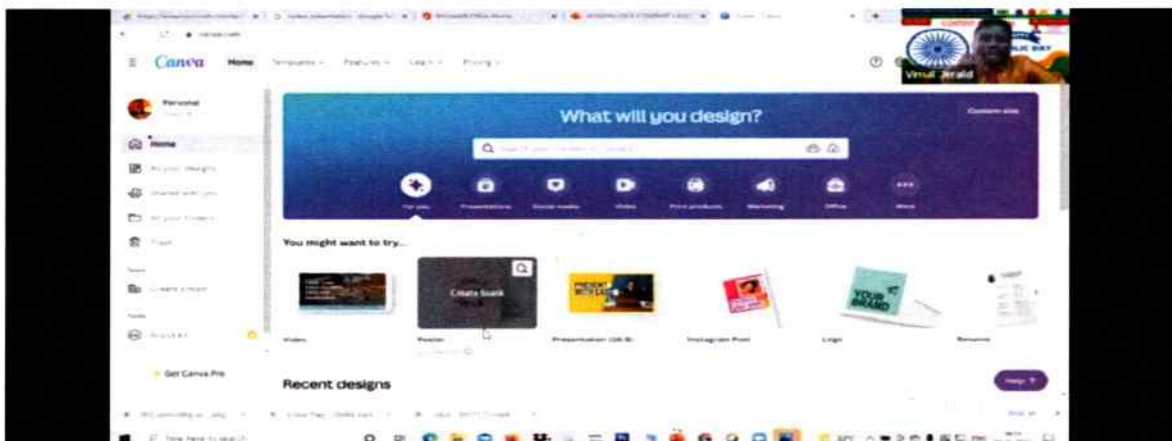

The college affiliated to Manonmaniam Sundaramar University, has attained Autonomous Status in the year 2009. In NIRF and AICTE ranking 2021 the college has also added laurels to its excellence.</p> <p>About the Department Department of Economics is one of the first Departments established (B.A. Economics with History as Auxiliary) in 1961. An Aided Course, the UG Department of Economics had celebrated its Diamond Jubilee (1961-2011) in the year 2011 and celebrating its Platinum Jubilee in 2021. Our department was upgraded with Post Graduation as self-supporting course in the year 2013. The Sanctioned Strength of the department is 73 for UG and 25 for PG. Presently the Department holds the faculty strength of eight with 5 doctorates. The department's faculty members completed 3 UGC Minor Research Projects, one ICSSR ongoing project, have published 32 books with 2 Edited Books and have presented and published more than 260 research papers in various national and international conference proceedings and Journals. The department has organized 1 International Web Conference, 2 International Webinars, 1 International Seminar, 15 National and State level Seminars and Workshops in which one was sponsored by Ministry of Forest and Environment and 4 others were sponsored by UGC.
