The UG and PG Department of Physics visited Tuticorin Airport on 10th September 2022 with 21 students and 3 staff members. The students entered the airport at 10.30 A.M. They viewed the landing of Indigo aircraft from Chennai at 10.53 A.M. Some photographs were also taken. Then they visited the Airport Fire Service Department. The Officer Mr. Kannan explained about the fire service work undertaken at the airport. If any fire accident happened, they had three imported vehicles with automated computer setup, probably around 6 crores each to reach the aircraft within 30 seconds to secure the passengers from danger. The officers also explained about the communication system and also the frequency range at which the signals were received. The local frequency range was about 122.400 MHz and the frequency range between Air Traffic Control and the pilot was 166.525 MHz. The job offers and recruitment in the field of airlines were also discussed by the officers. At the end the students had a view of the take off of the Indigo aircraft at 11.20 A.M. They winded up from the airport by 11.45 A.M. This field visit to the Tuticorin Airport was really informative and a new experience to the students.
