
PROGRAMS ORGANIZED BY THE COUNSELING FORUM 2023-2024

- Inspired by Hon'ble Prime Minister's 'Pariksha Pe Charcha', the Commission celebrates 'Pariksha Parv' every year to celebrate exams along with children. These programmes will be scheduled in the month of February-March, after Hon'ble Prime Minister's Pariksha Pe Charcha, 2024. For this, the Commission has prepared a pool of Resource Persons to take sessions in the orientation-cum-sensitization programmes




