

On 12th December 2023, a one-day programme was organized to commemorate the 133rd Birth Anniversary of the legendary Tamil poet and freedom fighter, Subramania Bharathiyar. The event, titled "Perithinum Perithu Ketta Makivigen Barathi," featured a lecture by Dr. Soundhara Mahadevan, Associate Professor at Sadakathullah Appa College, Tirunelveli, and was attended by approximately 650 students. The programme included various competitions held earlier in the year on 6th July 2023, which were based on Bharathiyar's life and work. These included essay writing (Pattap Pagalil Oru Nettai Kanavu), poem writing (Vaiyath Thalaimai Kol), and elocution (Bharathier Arivial Parvai). The winners of these competitions were Mahalakshmi S. (III Physics), Karunya K. (I English Literature), and Mukthar Kavitha S. (III Mathematics) in the essay writing category; George Sweetly J. (II Physics), Manimala K. (I English Literature), and Steena V. (II Microbiology) in the poem writing category; and Asvarnika (III Chemistry) and Muthu Mathumitha (III History) in the elocution category.
