In the 2010s, the majority are interactive Web 2.0 websites, allowing visitors to leave online comments, and it is this interactivity that distinguishes them from other static websites. In that sense, blogging can be seen as a form of social networking service. Using Social network as a tool to reach the user community the college library organised the workshop. 110 participants including 12 Outsiders and few scholars, 38 Staff Members and 59 students participated in the workshop.

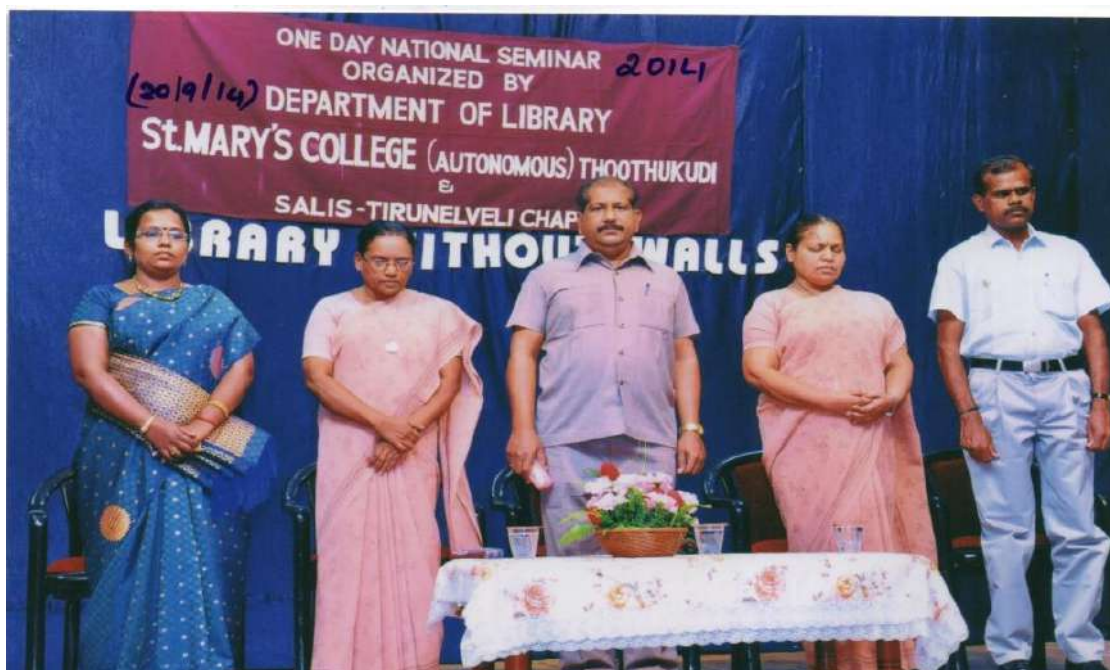
LIBRARY ACTIVITY PERIOD 2014-2015

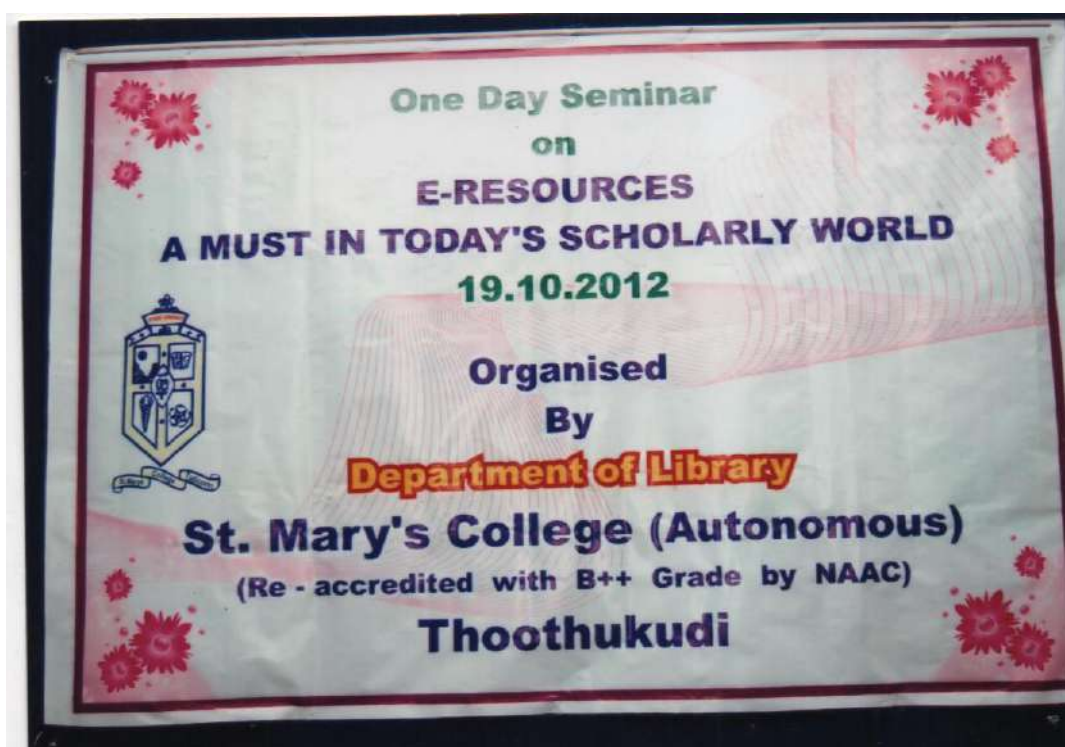


LIBRARY ACTIVITY PERIOD 2012-2013
