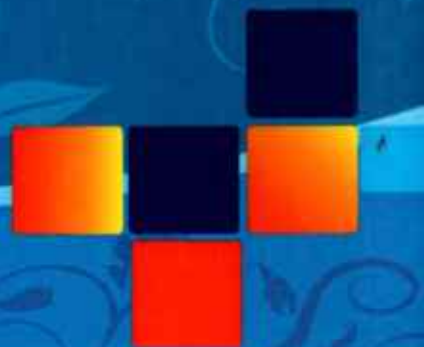

On this momentous occasion, I deem it a great privilege to have with us Dr. Daniel Ezhilarasu, General Secretary, All India Association for Christian Higher Education (AIACHE), New Delhi. At the outset, I feel elated to welcome our Chief Guest who has enthusiastically consented to be with us amidst his hectic schedule to share our joy and thanks giving. A warm and hearty welcome to you, Sir. I also feel delighted to extend my warm welcome to one and all gathered here. And now, with a sense of gratitude and accomplishment, I present before you the Annual Report of the academic year 2013-2014.

The attainment of 'A' Grade in January 2013 is a significant milestone in the journey of St. Mary's College towards the pinnacle of excellence. The newly added feather reinvigorated the spirit of the Marian family to march ahead, exploring the untrodden paths of glory. St. Mary's College has grown into a "mighty oak" and is forever determined to achieve growth in the challenging competitive global scenario, not only in terms of quantity but also in terms of quality.

Blessed by its Patron Mother Mary, St. Mary's College strives hard to translate the vision of its pioneers through the lofty mission of making young women agents of an egalitarian society. In keeping with our vision and in response to the needs of

our time, we aim at forming well-integrated persons, who will strive to transform the society by meeting the challenges of life and taking a stand in the struggles of the poor and marginalized.

Our dream for excellence is the formation of young women empowered to create a bright future for themselves and others, irrespective of caste, creed, religion or language and through dissemination of knowledge, skills and noble values. The past academic year was a fruitful one and I thank God Almighty for his abundant blessings and guidance.

The college functions under the able stewardship of the Principal, Dr. Sr. S. Decla with 89 learned professors and a co-operative team of 60 supportive staff members. The Self-Supporting Courses is run with 31 professors and 4 administrative staff members. The student strength in this academic year is 2327: 1689 under aided stream and 638 under self-supporting stream.

Our institution is endowed with a strong foundation of teaching and supporting staff. The strength of the institution lies in the selfless service, dedication, oneness and teamspirit of the teaching faculty. This is the most befitting moment to recognize and appreciate the academic success of our learned faculty members. The management is happy to congratulate and appreciate Dr. Sr. A. S. J. AIACHE (All India Association for Christian Higher Education) conferred Dr. Sam Higginbottam's Award for the best Principals of India for the year 2012 to 2013 on Dr. Sr. S. Decla for her academic leadership, administrative skill, social service and contribution to the society at large. She was also awarded an Outstanding Service Award by the Indian Association for the Blind on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2014 at Madurai in recognition of her outstanding excellence and amazing commitment towards

voluntary contribution to the empowerment of persons with visual challenges.

**Dr. Sr. Jessie Fernando** has been awarded the Defence Secretary's Commendation Card from the Ministry of Defence for her committed and selfless service in N.C.C. in 2013. The award consists of a certificate, medal and incentive of Rs 5000/-. She also was selected to lead as contingent ANO of 2014 Republic Day Camp Contingent of Tamilnadu, Puducherry and Andaman & Nicobar from 1<sup>st</sup> -29<sup>th</sup> January 2014. She was specifically involved in the training of best cadet competition. She was also the core committee member in the board of framing syllabus for the Non-Major Elective in the Madurai group.

Mrs. S. Thenmozhi, Associate Professor of French, was one among twenty Indian teachers of French to be selected by the Embassy of France and Institut Francais to attend a scholarship cum training programme held at Sevres, near Paris for a period of two weeks in the month of December. Her project aimed at tapping the intelligence of the students through proper evaluation methods.

**Publications** are also an essential feature of research. I congratulate and appreciate the efforts of the faculty of the Department of Economics for publishing a book on "Enterpreneurial Guidance". I also congratulate Dr. Mrs. D. Amutha of the Department of Economics for getting four of her books published.

Changes are an inevitable part of administrative policies. We wholeheartedly thank our former administrative heads Sr. C. Shibana, Dr. Sr. Jessie Fernando and Dr. Sr. Betsy for their commendable service as Vice-Principal, Controller of Examinations and Director of Self-Supporting Courses respectively. With the same fervour we welcome and wish our new Vice Principal Sr. K. Reetha, Controller of Examinations

Sr. S. Kulandai Therese and Sr. C. Shibana Director of Self-Supporting Courses. We also greet our new Dean of Arts, Mrs. X. Esther Vimala. We assure our support to them for more productive results in the days to follow.

The faculty members have been vibrant in updating themselves with the current trends of research and their proposals for major and minor research projects have been sanctioned by the UGC and by the Department of Science and Technology. The Department of Mathematics has received a grant of Rs.2,14,870 from the Department of Science and Technology. This fund was utilized by the Department to organise a three day National Seminar and Exhibition to commemorate the 125<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of the great mathematician Srinivasa Ramanujan.

Our college has been recognised as a DST-FIST college by the Department of Science and Technology, New Delhi with a grant of 70 lakhs. We have received the first instalment of Rs.35,50,000 and it is utilised for setting up a Central Computer Lab and procuring research and teaching equipments. Dr. Sr. S. Decla, our Principal has received a grant of Rs. 3,12,000 for her Major Research Project. Dr. Mrs. Glory, Associate Professor of Botany and Dr. R. D. Thilaga Associate Professor of Zoology have received a grant of Rs. 7,60,800 and Rs.12,10,800 for their major research projects respectively.

The growth of the institution is marked by the commencement of new courses. This year M.A. Economics has been started as a Self-Supporting Course. The Departments of Commerce and English have been upgraded as Research Centres and were inaugurated on 24<sup>th</sup> July and 31<sup>st</sup> July respectively. A proposal has been sent to upgrade the Department of Mathematics as Research Centre. We have implemented NCC as an Elective Subject in the Curriculum of the second year UG

course from this academic year. The library keeps expanding to keep pace with the latest trends in all the branches of study. Our library has been selected one among the ten at the National Level in accessing e-resources under UGC-INFLIBNET (N-LIST) this year.

We congratulate the Department of History and Tourism for being bestowed with the Best Department Award for the year 2013-2014. Their excellent contribution to the growth and development of the institution is very much commendable. The Twentieth Annual Session of the Tamil Nadu History Congress was organized by the Department of History and Tourism from September 20<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> with more than 600 participants from all over India. On 6<sup>th</sup> January 2014 the World Wide Coins and Stamps Collection Exhibition was conducted by Signature Philatelic Promoter Link. UGC has sanctioned a grant of Rs 1,60,000 to the Department of History and Tourism for the Foundation Course on Human Rights. As a part of this course a Regional level workshop on Human Rights was held on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2013 with a panel of lawyers. A Demo Moot Court Competition on the theme 'Women's Rights' was organised on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2014.

**The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)** has remarkably contributed to the improvement of quality in our institution and it conducted two eventful programmes, both sponsored by autonomous grant. On 24<sup>th</sup> September 2013, we had a workshop on "Towards Enhancement of Research Opportunities", as the NAAC Peer Team suggested to evince more interest in Research. The resource person, Dr. Melchias Gabriel, Dean of Sciences, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Trichy, spoke on the prospects of research opportunities in Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). It proved to be quite beneficial that many of the faculty set out to write proposals.

The even semester witnessed a Two-day National Seminar on "Institutional Quality Improvement: Role of Information and Communication Technology" held on 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> January 2014 as per the recommendation of NAAC. It was an enriching experience with resource persons from Kerala, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu. The resource persons who spoke on themes related to the objectives of the seminar, i.e., mediation of ICT in Curriculum; integration of ICT in Teaching and Learning; use of ICT for effective Administration and ICT-competency for Teachers of HEIs.

Usage of ICT tools can make phenomenal changes in the arena of higher education. To encourage the usage of ICT tools extensively, all the departments are provided with Interactive Boards which are powerful tools in the classroom, adding interactivity collaboration and allowing the integration of media content into the lecture and supporting collaborative learning. I am sure that my faculty members will take up this challenge of using it innovatively.

The organisation of three National Seminars, by the Departments of English and Economics and IQAC in this academic year, bears testimony to the fact that the institution works towards promoting research aptitude. A two day National Seminar on "Writing the Feminine : Contemporary Cross-cultural Women Writers" was organised by the Department of English on 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> January, in collaboration with the Department of English, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University. The Management and the Research Department of English organized 'Rev. Dr. Sr. Beatina Mary Endowment Lecture' on 26<sup>th</sup> February. The endowment lecture was a fruitful endeavour to academically orient the memory of a visionary sister, who had been the former principal of the college and Head of the Department of English. The endowment lecture was given by

Dr. Bhagyashree Varma, Associate professor of Mumbai University. She addressed on "The systems of thought in Modern Gender Theorists".

The Department of Economics organised a State Level Inter-collegiate Quiz Competition on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2013 and a National Seminar on "Human Resource Development Perspectives and Strategies" on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> February 2014, in collaboration with Thoothukudi District Tiny and Small Scale Industries Association. The Department of Botany conducted a seminar on "Herbal Research Methodology" on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2014 followed by a grand Herbal Exhibition on the 9<sup>th</sup>. In the UGC sponsored PG innovative programme MHRM, an inter-collegiate competition FLAIR 2014 was organized by the Department of Human Resource Management on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2014.

Out of Rs.40,00,000 sanctioned by the UGC for PG innovative program MHRM we have received a grant of Rs.23,00,000. From UGC we have received Rs.9,00,000 for the construction of building for Women Studies, Rs.7,00,000 as UG assistance and Rs.45,00,000 as additional assistance. Out of 70 lakhs sanctioned we have got 63 lakhs for the construction of multipurpose indoor stadium.

**Library** the gate way to knowledge has ample collection of around **46,650 Books, 2154 e-journals and 120 Periodicals to enrich knowledge of the user community.** CCTV with 16 port cameras are fixed at various points in the library and a LED monitor with DVR is fixed at the lobby of the library for security purpose. UPS of 3KVA is available at the library to have uninterrupted power supply. Entry into the library is monitored by a Biometric Gate Register. The library has added **528 books and 10 periodicals** during the year 2013-2014. Transactions and

data entry in the library have been automated. All the books are being barcoded to speed up the issue or return process.

The new computer lab for MHRM was inaugurated on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2013. Career-oriented courses like Tally, DOTNET and English for Professional Competency, LaTeX, Front Office Management, Training in Soft Skills, Applied Informative Chemistry, ASP.NET, Basic Hardware and Networking and Functional English have been introduced for the third year UG students to ensure employability. **Certificate Courses** like Spoken English, Hindi, Tally, Computer Application, Insurance Consultancy, Women Entrepreneurship, Dietetics and Herbal Care, were offered to the I and II year Under Graduate students. The Department of Zoology has received one time seed money of Rs. 10,00,000 for 5 years from UGC to conduct Career Oriented Programme (COP) on "Ornamental Fish Management". This programme includes Certificate, Diploma, and Advanced Diploma Courses.

Good teachers are great assets to the institution. The strong support and co-operation which I always enjoy from our faculty members have lightened my task of administration and has enhanced the Marian family spirit. This family is obliged to bid adieu to three of its teaching and two non-teaching faculty. Retirement of experienced and dedicated teachers is undoubtedly a loss to any institution. A few words cannot substitute the silent contributions of these committed and efficient staff members. Yet, with appreciation and gratitude, the management pays a delighted encomium.

With immense sense of gratitude the college acknowledges the meritorious service rendered by **Dr. Sr. S. Decla** who has served loyally and tirelessly for 30 years in the Department of History. To her credit, she was enthroned as Director of Self-Supporting Courses, Vice Principal, First Controller of

Examinations and Principal. Her countless contributions, dedicated, committed and yeomen service has brought name and fame to our institution. She strived very hard to make the teachers and students to communicate in English for which she is a role model. There was a unique equilibrium in the academic and cultural growth of the college during her period. **The academic year 2013-2014** commenced on 20<sup>th</sup> June with renewed vigour and new hope. The faculty were geared to work with more commitment and devotion. They were oriented towards a new, fruitful academic year with the participative lectures of Rev. Dr. Fr. Selvarathinam, Dean of Theology, Gnana Deepa Vidhya Peeth, Pune. The event also featured a felicitation to the principal, Rev. Sr. S. Decla on her receiving the Best Principal award and a warm welcome accorded to the new administrators, the Vice Principal, Rev. The value education we impart through **Moral and Christian Doctrine** classes and the Holy Mass conducted on first Fridays of every month, equips them with values to uphold throughout their lives. Besides first Friday Mass and the Holy Spirit Mass, annual retreats for the staff and students were also conducted. Extra lectures and seminars were also organized to give the students spiritual and moral values. Reetha efficiently manoeuvres all the campus activities.

**The All India Catholic University Federation (AICUF)** of our college fosters awareness of societal problems among students. The **Entrance and Exit interviews** conducted for the students, the former by the HODs for the first year students at the time of their entry into the college and the latter by the Principal for the third year outgoing students, pave way for betterment of facilities and amenities.

The activities of the college are enlivened by **Clubs and Committees** which encourage team spirit, participatory, decision making and leadership skills.

The **Quiz Club** mobilised approximately 120 students, determined to increase their knowledge and made sincere endeavours to augment their efficiency through periodic

gatherings and focussed on dissemination of knowledge.

**Consumer Citizen Club** functions with a view to enhance the rights and responsibilities of the consumers. This club functions effectively with 50 members.

**Anti- Sexual Harassment Cell** of our college organised a meeting on 9<sup>th</sup> January. Mrs. S. Swarnalatha, Advocate , Notary Public, created an awareness on cyber crime, child abuse, sexual harassment of women at workplace.

**The Anti- Ragging Cell** of the college is very vigilant and as a proactive measure, awareness against ragging was initiated at the beginning of the academic year. The college creates a secure environment for the students due to the strong discipline maintained and so incidents of ragging have not taken place at any level.

The annual **Thirukkural Exam** orients the students to greater values. 456 First year students and 326 Second year students have appeared for their Thirukkural exam. In the State level Thirukkural Exam conducted by the Ulaga Tamil Peravai, we have been the proud achievers of second and third ranks this year.

**Red Ribbon Club** sensitised the students to de-addiction and drug dependency, the major social evils. Various strategies to help the affected individuals were highlighted. Informative lectures on HIV/ AIDS were arranged on 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2014. Mr. E. Baskar Paniraj, District Manager, RRC addressed the students on 'AIDS awareness'.

The **Youth Red Cross** comprises of 150 student volunteers. They visit periodically the Government Medical College Hospital and render their service to "May I Help You" counter. Dr. Sevvil Murugan, RMO, RPCT Hospital, Punnaikayal enlightened the students on the importance of First Aid.

Our successful academic journey is strongly supported by the stakeholders, the parents with whom we have established vital links in view of the betterment of their wards. The **Parent Teacher Association** was formed to foster closer ties with the parents. Parent Teacher Association organised an orientation programme for I year students along with their parents on 26<sup>th</sup> June. They are apprised of the rules and regulations of the college. A series of meetings were organised, with a bid to strengthen the rapport between parents and teachers. Parents meet the teachers twice in a year and this co-ordination ensures success in the students' academic life.

**Human Rights Forum** organised a play on 'Kothadimai Ozhippu' on 8<sup>th</sup> October, demonstrated by a team of NGO's. On 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of December, a two day education programme on 'Human Rights' was conducted by the **International Association for Religious Freedom (IARF)** and Sacred Heart Brothers. Brother Albert Xavier, Facilitator, Human Rights Resume centre, Bengaluru and Bro. Britto instilled insights on the Declaration and Articles on Human Rights among the participants. World Human Rights Day was celebrated on 10<sup>th</sup> December. 4 members of **Human Rights Forum** participated in the Annual Summit 2014 organised by the International Association for Religious Freedom on 27<sup>th</sup> January 2014, at Montfort College, Bengaluru. National Voters' Day was celebrated on 25<sup>th</sup> January.

**Road Safety Patrol** cadets live up to the motto of "we live to serve". RSP consists of 50 cadets. They take charge of traffic regulation in front of the college. A meeting was conducted on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2014 in which Mr. H. Felix Masillamani Motor Vehicle Inspector, Regional Transport office, gave a speech on "Law to avoid accidents" and emphasised the need for getting licenses from the RTO office.

**ECO Club**, functioning with a vision to instill in the minds of the students the need to lead an eco-friendly life takes initiatives to maintain an eco-friendly environment in the campus. Boards with inspirational quotes were installed in the campus to motivate our future generation of students to take care of our planet and to protect Mother Earth.

The activities of **Think Tank** help the students to enrich and enhance their creative skills and ensure them a better performance in their examinations. A documentary Appraisal Show "Inspiration-Your Ultimate Calling" was presented by Dr. Wayne. It reiterated to the members that the dormant forces and talents come alive and one discovers one's self and the potentials.

**The Counselling Cell** organizes periodical, general, behavioural, medical counselling sessions. It takes sincere initiatives to help the students to overcome psychological traumas. The presence and the counsel of a counsellor helps them to understand and realize their situation.

**The Career Guidance Cell** effectively operates having in view the trend of placements and employability in the job market. The Cell conducted a work shop focussing on soft-skills, interview skills, resume writing and group discussions. A Seminar was organized for all the PG Students on the topic "Human Resource Development and Method of Developing Communication Skills" on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2013. Workshop on "Entrepreneurship and Import and Export" was conducted on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2013 for all the final year UG Students. In the campus interview conducted for the post of teachers at Vellammal Bodhi Education Institution, organised for PG Students, 10 of our students received placement orders. We expect many of our students to be placed in On Campus and Off Campus interviews to be conducted during March 2014.

Elevation of the spirit towards healthy and peaceful living is the mission of **Yoga and Meditation Club**. The club has fruitfully trained and engaged the students in acquiring yoga skills. The **Scribes Forum** established with the main objective of helping the visually challenged children, functions successfully. They excelled in their role as scribes for the blind children at Caldwell Boys Higher Secondary School, Thoothukudi during their examinations.

Realizing the importance of the need for self defence for women, the college gives **Karate** classes for the students. Our karate students have mastered a great number of skills under the able guidance of Master Bhaskaravel and display their skills to the other students on our Sports Day.

Besides academic and spiritual upliftment a complete formation is provided through **co-curricular and extra-curricular** activities. Our students, fired with enthusiasm, blazed a trail of success in various extra-curricular activities. They participated in many cultural competitions in and around Thoothukudi and won several prizes. They made their mark in 'Suvadugal' 2013 organised by Lady Doak College, Madurai. Our students won the overall shield in the 'Maha Ruby Fest' organised by APC Mahalaxmi College for women, Thoothukudi on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2014. In the Youth Leadership Programme organized by the Toast Master's Club, Thoothukudi from 14<sup>th</sup> December 2013 5<sup>th</sup> January 2014, twenty five students of our college participated. Port Trust, Thoothukudi jointly organised the **4<sup>th</sup> Arivukkalanjiyam Women Awards Competition** in connection with the International Women's Day Celebrations in our college on 22<sup>nd</sup> February. 45 students of our college won prizes in various competitions and S. It is a rare occasion in NCC Battalion ie 3(TN) Girls BN NCC, Tirunelveli to have 3 cadets of the same institution participating in TSC, in the same year. I thank and appreciate all the NCC staff for the training imparted to our cadets among whom some have stood up to make us proud.
