The External Experts appreciated the college and offered the following suggestions:

Rev. Fr. Dr. Britto appreciated the detailed report of the Secretary and the infrastructure development made in the college. He also appreciated the active implementation of Star College Scheme and the efforts made to highlight the important features of the Constitution through various programmes.

Rev. Sr. Dr. S. Decla, the Chairperson appreciated the significant progress made by the college, particularly the training imparted to teachers and advised to go forward to systematically examine the quality of teachers and students in order to improve the quality of education. She emphasised the staff members to get themselves updated for academic excellence. She sought clarification on the impact of UGC's recent guidelines on Research / NET. Dr. Serena Margaret, IQAC Coordinator explained that the UGC announcement about NET pass as the mandatory criterion for Ph. D registration may affect the number of research scholars; she informed that UGC is yet to announce in detail the procedural guidelines on its decision that the students who have completed the 4 years UG course can apply for NET if they want to pursue Ph.D.

Dr. Sr. S. Decla also enquired about the NIRF ranking of our college and Dr. Serena Margaret clarified that our college participated in NIRF and secured a prominent place in 101-150 Rank band in NIRF 2021 and NIRF 2022 and 151-200 Rank band in NIRF 2023 Rankings. She explained that the variance between the sanctioned intake and the admitted strength play a crucial role in the result of NIRF ranking though the institution has improved in other parameters every year.

Rev. Sr. Dr. Mary Joyce Baby, Vice Chairperson, congratulated and commended the institution for the developments made and for the JRF scholarships received.

Rev. Dr. Sr. S. Kulandai Therese explained about the UBA fund and said that the activities of CDP will be undertaken based on the fund.

The meeting concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Dr. N. Arokiya Mary, Senior faculty & Associate Professor of Zoology.
